Overall Awards

Biggest Donor Award

The team who raises the most money in their community to donate to breast cancer will win this award. Teams can raise their money in the community however they feel appropriate. All money will be collected during team check-in on the day of the event. The top 3 teams overall will be recognized and the top team will receive a Think Pink banner for their gym.

All Community Award

By attending our event and bringing members of your community to support your team, you are achieving one of our event's goals: raising awareness of breast cancer. Throughout the day, we will keep a running tally at the door of spectators from your community who attend our event. The top three teams will be recognized and the top awarded the "All Community Award."

Traveling Trophy

This award goes to the team who travels the distance to support our cause. The Traveling Trophy will be awarded to the team that has traveled the furthest to our event based on the school/gym address given on your registration form.

Individual Awards Jump-Off Awards
